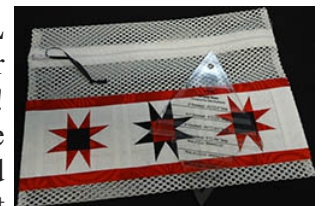


MARINER'S COMPASS
